Job Responsibilities

- Provide weekly maintenance on pools, including vacuuming, cleaning walls, slides, diving boards, etc.
- Skin water surfaces to clear debris
- Check systems to ensure they are functioning properly
- Clean out skimmer baskets, cleaner bags, wall screens, hair strainer baskets, etc.
- Test and balance pool water and record results
- Communicate with customers when necessary and respect their property
- Perform other duties as required

Requirements

- High School Diploma, GED or equivalent
- Maintain health and safety standards at all times
- Strong problem solving and communication skills
- Well-developed leadership abilities
- Ability to maintain a professional demeanor at all times when representing the company
- Valid Driver's license and clean driver's abstract

Work Conditions

- This position requires the ability to travel and employees are to provide their own transportation to and from work
